

# TARGET RACE

## ATTENTION 2010 MICHIGAN IBRA CONTESTANTS:

This year at state finals we will be having a side pot Target Race. The winner will receive a Gist Buckle that has been sponsored by Curt and Renee Yerger and Split Pine Acres. All proceeds will be put into the Michigan IBRA Show fund. We would like to extend a big thank you to Curt and Renee for coming up with this idea and sponsoring the buckle!

Here is how the Target Race will work.

Entry fee is \$5 per horse. You can enter more than one horse and if you are a youth or masters rider who enters the open you can enter the same horse twice, however your youth or masters run time will be used with your youth or masters time from Friday to Saturday. Your open time Friday will be matched with your open time from Saturday. The horse and rider team that runs the closest to their Friday run time on Saturday will be the buckle winner.

Example:

Rider #1

Friday open time 15.000

Saturday open time 15.100

Difference in time is .100

Rider#2

Friday youth time 15.100

Saturday youth time 14.900

Difference is .200

Rider #1 is the winner of the target race.

This is a very fun race and is achievable for the fastest or slowest horse to win, consistency is key. We encourage everyone to enter and try their luck to win this beautiful buckle that is valued at nearly \$500!
